APPLICATION PROCESS

- We consider applicants who are licensed professionals or advanced interns in the mental health field: MDs, psychologists, LMFTs, social workers, and psychiatric nurses
- Complete an application
- Send all required documents
- Complete two personal interviews
- The review process takes 4-8 weeks
- Space in the program is limited

FEES

- Application Fee: \$50 (Waived before June 15)
- Yearly Administration Fee: \$100
- Tuition: \$2,250 per Year
