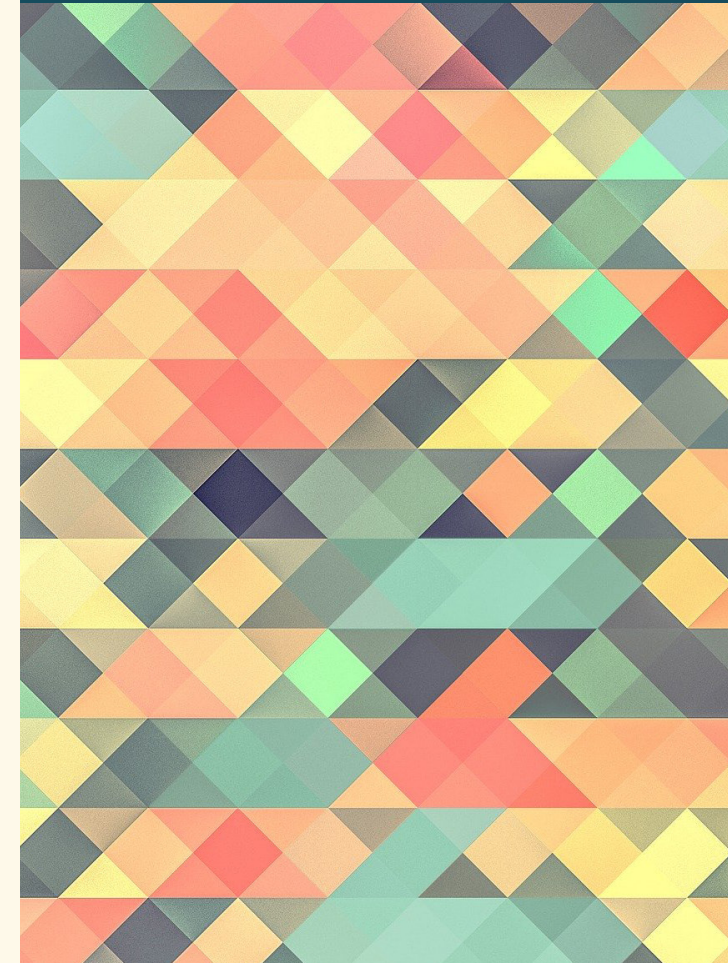

## The Tripartite Training Model

### 1. Learn from being a patient

Deep and intensive self-exploration can be one of the most valuable experiences in the process of becoming a psychoanalyst. Personal psychoanalysis is the foundation of training. We encourage you to start the process by meeting with one of NCP's training analysts.

### 2. Learn from being a student

Weekly classes held over the span of four years will expose you to a range of analytic thought. A spirit of open and critical inquiry defines our seminars. Our program is diverse and dynamic, encouraging candidates to develop their own unique style. You will learn from our prestigious and experienced faculty members.

### 3. Learn from your patients

As part of the training, you will be required to have three psychoanalytic cases under supervision, and you can choose an NCP training analyst to supervise you in each case.
