## THE PROGRAM

The Child and Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Program is a unique two-year clinical training which follows development from birth through adolescence, examining and building upon the internal and external challenges inherent to the experience of the child. Our accomplished faculty teach those who work with children and adolescents to become more knowledgeable and effective in treating the complex intra-psychic, interpersonal and environmental challenges commonly felt by today's youth. Additionally, the Program addresses the importance of initiating and maintaining alliances with parents during the treatment process.

A certificate of completion is awarded upon the successful completion of the Program.

## FIRST YEAR

- An Overview of the Techniques of Child Therapy
- The First Interview and Beginning Phase
- Assessment of Parent/Child Attachment and Developmental History
- Application of the Basic Psychoanalytic Principles such as the setting, the play space, the therapeutic alliance, enactments, counter-transference, the use of fantasy, play and dreams
- Failures in Attachment; Childhood Trauma
- Psychoanalytic Theory of Development from Birth to 3 Years
- Psychosexual Development from 3 to 6 Years
- Latency and working with schools
- Effects of Technoculture, Children's Literature

## SECOND YEAR

- Psychoanalytic Theory of Development from Puberty through Adolescence
- OCD, Body Dysmorphic Disorder, Eating Disorders, Self-Mutilation, Substance Abuse in Adolescence
- Developmental Psychopathology: Anxiety, Depression and Development Delays, Oppositional and Aggressive Behavior, Impulse Disorders, ADHD
- Identity Issues, Gender Identity Disorder
- Neurobiology of Autistic Spectrum Disorders and the Aspergers' Child
- Psychopharmacology with Children & Adolescents
- Psychoanalytic Technique of Working with Parents
